

- 1. Registration Begins April 14th.
- 2. Campers must be age appropriate by the first day of camp.
- 3. Registration is on a first come first get basis.
- 4. Payments for camp are due on THURSDAY, 1 Week Prior to services rendered.
- 5. You are considered registered for a week of camp when a full payment is received for that week.
- 6. A nonrefunable \$25 registration fee is due upon signing up for any week.
- 7. One camp shirt is included with your registration.
- 8. A \$50 weekly deposit is required to save your spot each week.
- 9. There are no refunds. Refunds are subject to a 15% processing fee.
- 10. There will be additional fees for any shadows accompanying campers.
- 11. Parents/Guardians will be held responsible for determining payments between families who do not share a household.
- 12. All trips and activities are subject to change without prior notice.
- 13. Parents are not allowed to drop off campers at trips if bus is missed.
- 14. By participating in our programs, patrons agree to allow the City of Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks, the Tarzana Rec. Center and Camp Tarzana to use photographs, video tapes, and testimonials of participants for use in publicity materials free of any fee or usage charge.


